

Editorial

Essentials of Dentistry has transitioned to a continuous publishing model in 2025. This change aims to streamline the publication process and ensure swifter online dissemination for the benefit of both authors and readers. Due to a rise in submissions and the subsequent acceptance rate of papers, the timeframe for online publication, based on the monthly budgeted number of online pages, has been extended. The adoption of continuous publishing will facilitate a more efficient path to official publication.

The continuous publishing (CP) model offers significant advantages enabling the immediate publication of an article as soon as it is ready. This means that articles can be published promptly after they have undergone peer review, received approval from the Editorial Board, and been copyedited, typeset, and proofread. This ensures that an approved article doesn't need to wait for the completion of a specific journal issue, thereby enhancing the service provided to writers and readers by facilitating faster dissemination to the scientific community.

Under this new model, articles will be ready for publication as soon as they are accepted, copyedited, and professionally formatted with all author corrections completed. Articles will be published online as the final version of record, including full citation details with volume and issue, and full-text HTML and PDF formats. Page numbers are replaced with ID numbers derived from the articles' original submission IDs.

We hope that this transition will enhance the quality of the journal and ensure more timely online publication.
